Due to an increase in Service Planning workload and stabilization of the recent re-organization of Service Planning, the Company has a need for temporary staff augmentation of the Service Planning department.

The Company has engaged the firm Progressive Global Energy to provide temporary agency employees to assist Service Planning. Temporary employees will be deployed in the locations shown:

The Company and Union agree that these workers are temporary agency personnel per section 27.2.c of the Contract. As such, regular employees may provide them training and direct their work. In addition, the Union agrees to an extension of the 120-day time limit to a limit of six months – i.e. from August 20, 2018 through February 19, 2019. The Company will not dismiss Hiring Hall New Business employees (NBR/SNBR/IPE) or Hiring Hall Estimating employees within Service Planning during this time, except on an individual basis either for cause or as provided for in Exhibit C, Section H.
