Dear Mr. Sperry:

The Company and Union previously agreed in Letter of Agreement 18-15-ESC to a Company-provided pilot program that focused on employees who have experienced multiple on-the-job injuries and how to help prevent future injuries for those employees. Specifically, the "Fit4U" pilot was intended to accelerate the recovery process and help prevent future injuries for employees who have multiple workers' compensation claims by offering these employees additional services such as:

- Health coaching
- Nutrition
- Personal training

The pilot concluded and due to a favorable response, the Company is proposing a company-wide launch of PG&E's Fit4U program. As with the pilot, participation in the Program will be voluntary and free for employees. The Company will maintain the right to modify or cancel this program in its sole discretion. Prior to any modification or cancellation, however, the Company will provide the union advance notice.
