

AB 1041 authored by Assemblymember Buffy Wicks, would ensure that California workers are able to be there for their loved ones when it matters most by adapting our leave laws to include chosen and extended family.

AB 1949 authored by Assemblymember Evan Low, would provide up to 5 days of unpaid bereavement leave for California employees who work for employers with 5 or more employees.

AB 2182 authored by Assemblymember Buffy Wicks, would protect California workers by ensuring that employers cannot discriminate against employees because of their family responsibilities. AB 2182 would also require employers to provide reasonable accommodations due to unforeseen school and care closures, such as changing the employee's schedule.

AB 2847 authored by Assemblymember Eduardo Garcia would provide a pilot program (1 yr) for unemployment for undocumented workers to receive money from the general fund that is in surplus of \$300/wk for 20 weeks.

SB 951 authored by Senator Maria Elena Durazo, would ensure that by January 1, 2025, low wage workers would receive 90% of their regular wages for the first 16 weeks of SDI and all 8 weeks of PFL. All other workers would receive 70% of their regular wages up to a maximum weekly benefit amount.

SB 114 authored by Senator Nancy Skinner, requires California employers with 26 or more employees to provide up to 80 hours of COVID-19 related Supplemental Paid Sick Leave, with up to 40 of those hours for isolation & quarantine, receiving vaccines, and caring for a child whose school or place of care is closed and up to an additional 40 of those hours available only when an employee, or family member for whom the employee provides care, tests positive for COVID-19. Enacted and signed by Governor Newsom

SB 364 authored by Senator Nancy Skinner – School meals for all; Builds on. Free school meal program by ensuring food access even when school is not in session

SB 854 authored by Senator Nancy Skinner -The Hope for Children Act – Provides Trust funds for children who lost a parent or primary caregiver to Covid-19 and for long term foster youth. Creates a state benefit for children who do not qualify for federal Social Security benefits after their parent passes away

SB 1115 authored by Senator Nancy Skinner – Women in Construction – Women continue to be underrepresented in the trades. Expands and improves opportunities for women in construction trades

SB 1142 co authored by Nancy Skinner Expanding access to Abortion Services – expands and enhances access to reproductive care, not only to Californians but to others who seek services here
