Memorandum of Understanding

The parties have recently met to discuss the upcoming implementation of Propel System Software at PG&E. As part of the development, design and deployment of this system, the Company will provide temporary management level assignments to ESC represented coworkers. These rotations are expected to last more than one year.

To support the effort, although the employees will be management level employees for pay purposes during the rotation, the parties have agreed that the following five coworkers on these temporary management assignments will have their time on rotation considered as experience in their base ESC represented classifications for the purposes of advancement under the provisions of Title 21. In addition, the time on these rotations will not negatively affect any future wage placements under the provisions of Title 15.

This agreement will continue during the length of the rotational assignments below. However, either the Company or the Union reserves the right to cancel this agreement by giving the other party thirty (30) days written notice.
